There is Fee relief that we have previously sent out, if you would like to apply for this fee please contact reception to obtain a form from Alex. If your child turns 4 years old on or before 31 July 2024 and is enrolled in a preschool program at an eligible long day care service, you will receive up to \$2,110 in fee relief. If your child is 3 years old and not yet 4 years old on, or before 31 July in 2024 and is enrolled at an eligible long day care service, you will receive up to \$500 in fee relief. If you have previously filled out a form you do need to fill out a new one for 2024.
